



Become part of the *Faith & Finances* ministry at MRPC

Beginning on February 24, 2024 we will begin a 12-week *Faith & Finances* financial education ministry where we will come together to discover God's purpose for our money. *Faith & Finances* is a ministry that empowers people with practical money management skills, biblical stewardship principles, and supportive relationships.

Faith & Finances is different from many other financial education programs. It's not about helping participants achieve wealth or material success. Rather, it aims to empower participants to experience restoration in their finances—and in their relationships.

In *Faith & Finances*, participants discover how Jesus is reconciling all things—including their money—and how God is using their finances to accomplish His work in the world. They also learn how to track income and expenses, save money, plan for emergencies, and pay off debt. At the same time, they receive support and encouragement from allies or encouragers who walk alongside them as they learn.

Who should take *Faith & Finances*?

Faith & Finances provides a relational approach to discovering God's purpose for our money in community. *Faith & Finances* is for people who:

- Are just starting out learning how to manage money
- Don't have a lot of money to spare.
- Desire to overcome financial obstacles
- Want to save more and pay off debt

What other ways are there to participate in *Faith & Finances*?

An Encourager is someone who participates in the class, builds relationships, talks to and prays for learners in the class. *We* need encouragers for the Spring *Faith & Finances* course.
